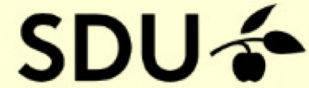

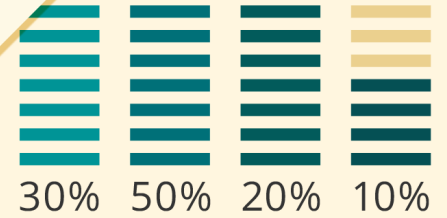
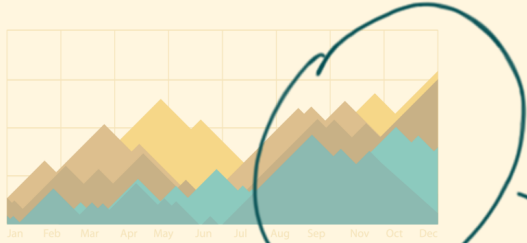
- Bring the **young European research universities perspective** to the EU debate.

- Promoting the implementation of **Open Science** at our member institutions.



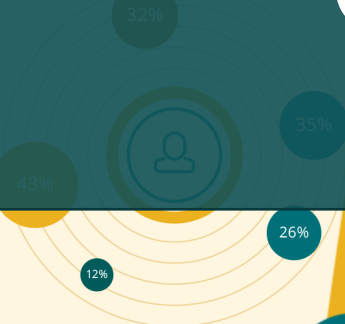
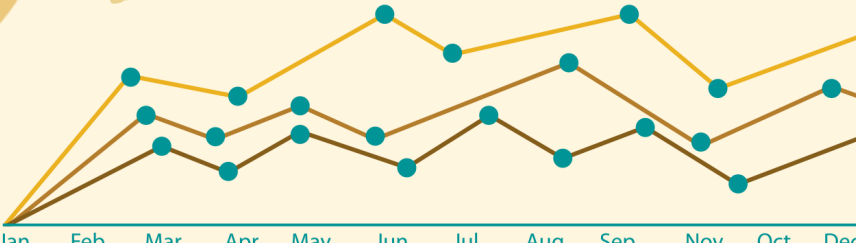
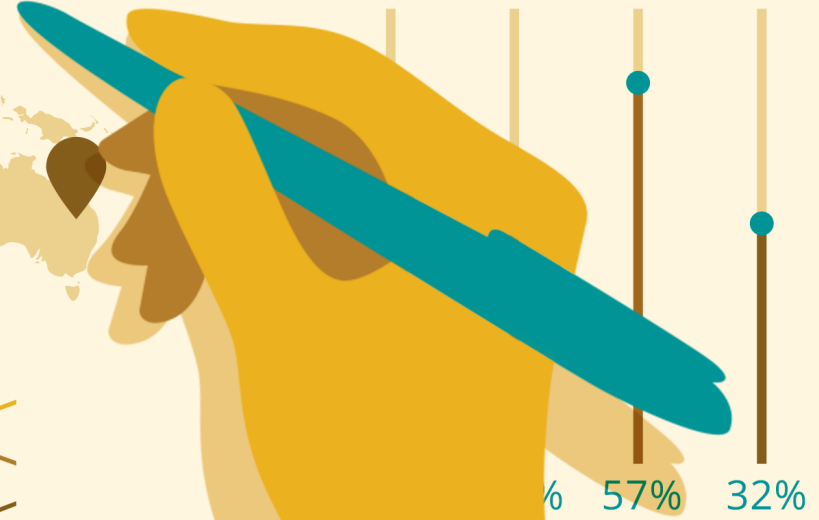

- **EU Open Science Policy Platform (EU-OSPP)**
 - The OSWG contribute through OSPP **Professor Eva Mendez**, also OSPP Chair.
 - Current focus on the development of 149 indicators for Open Science evaluation
 - Early opportunity to pilot test key draft indicators through the proposed **YERUN Excellent Open Science Champion Award** to evaluate individual researchers' OS success

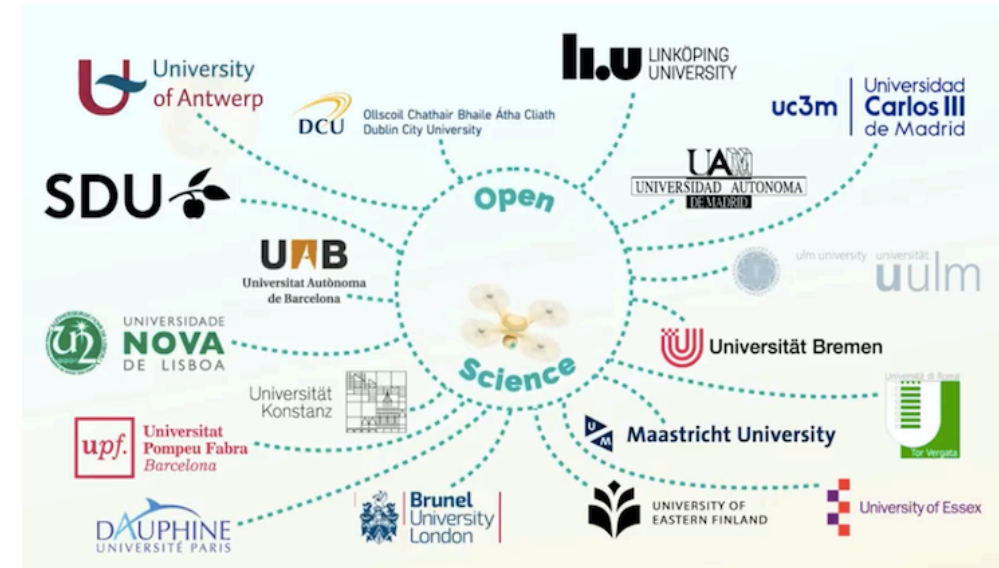

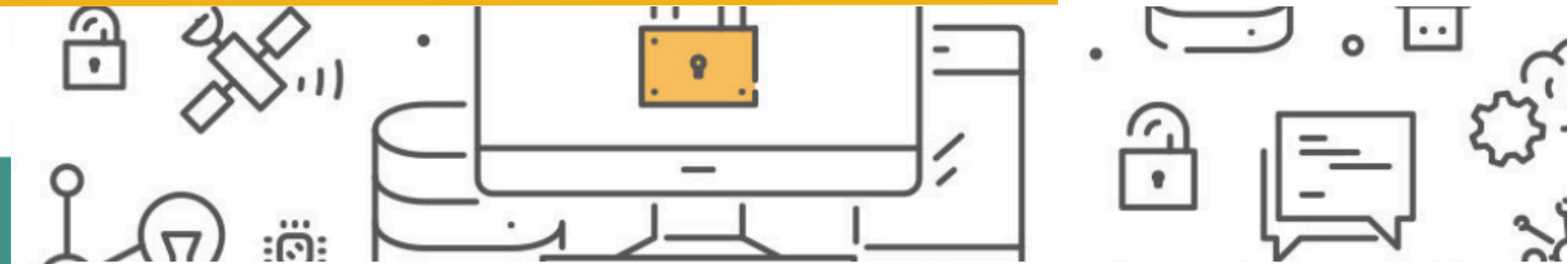

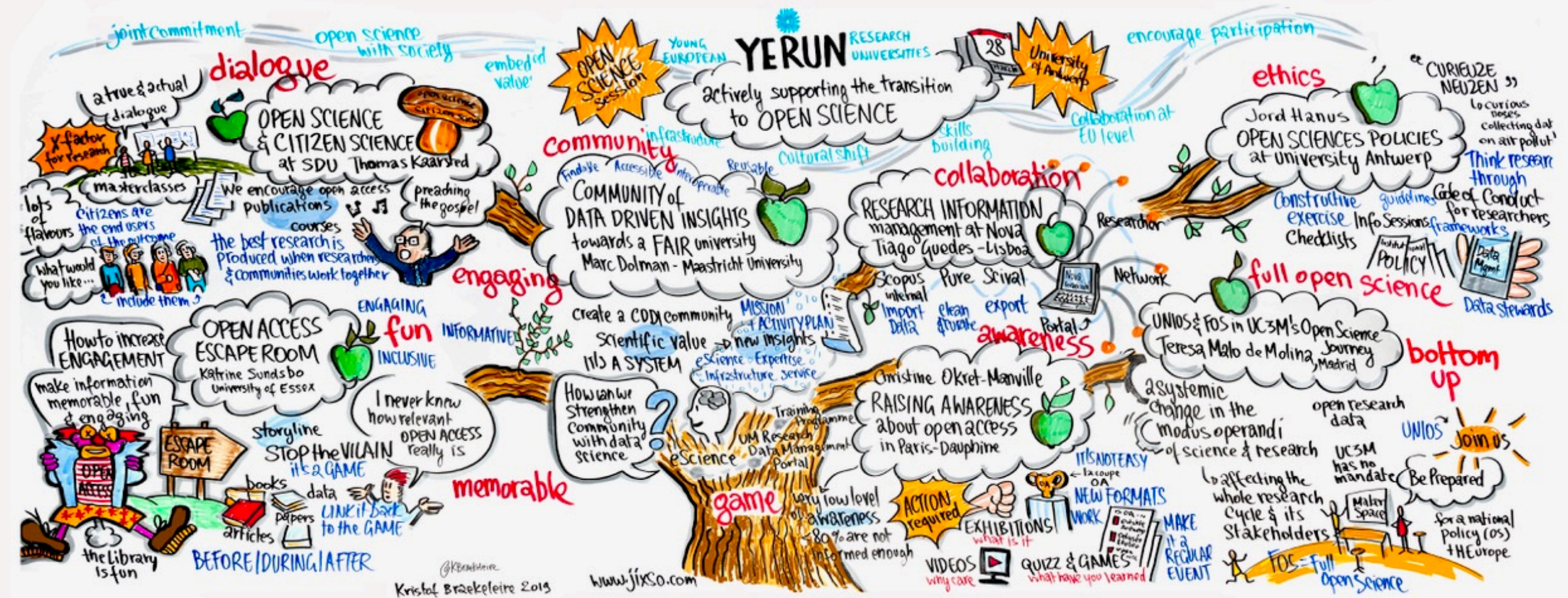
OSWG activities: in progress – next 6 months

■ Plan S

- Review of cOAlition S revised guidelines for Plan S implementation and the key priority actions identified light of impact for YERUN members.
 - Initial review sees YERUN feedback reflected in the revised guidelines, including a revised timescale for implementation now January 2021 and clearer focus on infrastructure.
- Assessing the best way to continue our engagement with cOAlition S on behalf of YERUN members.
- Engagement and education of members on Plan S implementation.
